Government Guidelines

- **Maximum group of 6**
(5 owners and dogs with trainer)
- **Use Personal Protective Equipment**
(face masks, gloves, glasses)
- **Must wash hands or/and use hand sanitiser**
- **Social Distancing**
(at present this 2 meters - this will be applied marking out by cones)
- **No hugging with friends outside of your social bubble**
(this is necessary so we do not pass on any infection)

Where will classes take place

We have tried to locate the best venues we can use and keep the risk to minimum. All the venues are outdoors and there is no wet weather accommodation.

These venues are a mix of hard surfaces, stoned paths and grass areas:

1. Sense Valley, Ibstock for our 121 training
2. Group training will take place at one of these venues:
 - The Malt Shovel, Worthington
 - Peggs Green, Colerton

How big are the group classes be?

The group classes will be restricted to 5 dogs with one owner or handler. These may change as government guidelines change.

How long are classes?

Our classes have been adapted for 5 dogs and these are now going to be for 45 mins for our obedience and 121 sessions. For ringcraft these will be 30 mins a group.

All training classes and 121 social distancing will be in place.

Between classes there will be a 15 mins change over again in social distancing in place.

What do I need to wear?

You will need to wear appropriate clothes and footwear for outdoors. Waterproof clothing is required and sensible footwear for the ground and weather conditions.

What do you need to be aware off?

During the classes you will need to make sure you have hand sanitisers as you could touch gate post, fence rails and bins. Owners/handlers attend classes at their own risk.

Will there be treats toys available on the day?

Unfortunately we are not able to offer treats and toys on the day. Prior to class or 121 training you can buy treats and toys via our online shop knightsbaydogtraining.com. These will come in safe carrier bag or box and must be paid for before training.

What PPE will be available?

Its owners and handlers to provide their own PPE protection if they wish to wear it while participating.

What facilities will be available?

Its owner/handlers responsibility to maintain dogs wellbeing at all times. Therefore you will need to bring dog lead and collar, fresh water, dog bowl, poop scoop facilities. There is no facilities for owner/handler, so please bring your own refreshments.

Can we help with collecting and putting out dog training equipment?

All equipment can only be handled by the instructor.

What happens if I start with COVID-19 in class or 121 training?

If you are showing any signs of COVID-19 you will be asked to leave and contact the appropriate services.

- **When do I make payment?**
 - All payments need to be made on return of booking form, unfortunately without payment prior to class we are not able to go ahead with training.
- **Can I pay by cash?**
 - Unfortunately with trying to minimise risk therefore we are not to accept cash payments, however you can make payment by PayPal, BACS or through the website.
- **Will the price of all the classes change?**
 - Only ringcraft (group) group classes will have an increase to £5 per dog.

- Groups of 5 or 121

▪ **Ringcraft classes**

- 30 mins sessions
- Groups of 5 or 121 training

▪ **Gundog Training**

- 45-90 mins sessions
- Groups of 5 or 121 training

▪ **Whistle Training**

- 30-60 mins
- 121 training

▪ **121 Training**

- 45-60 mins

For each class session:

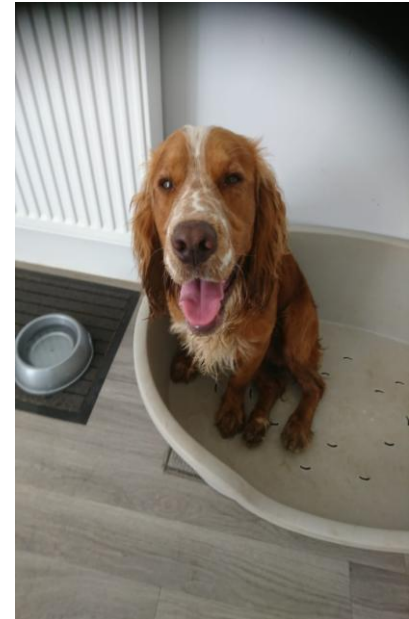
1) Make sure you have the right Personal Protective Equipment
